

Tab Reminders:

Numbers tell you FRET numbers...not finger numbers.  
Tab just tells you notes...you have to listen to figure out rhythm.

F# Major Scale - low octave

For this scale ONLY, fret numbers and finger numbers are the same.

F# Major Scale - high octave

For this scale ONLY, fret numbers and finger numbers are the same.

## F# Major Scale - 2 octaves

For this scale ONLY, fret numbers and finger numbers are the same.

|-----1-2-4-----4-2-1-----|
|-----2-4-----4-2-----|

## A Major Scale

For this scale, use the finger pattern from above on the frets noted in the tab...your first finger should be centered over fourth fret, your second finger over fifth fret, etc.
