

HIGHLANDER MARCHING BAND OFFICERS

Available *student-elected* offices:

President –

- Must be a senior with at least one previous year participating in marching band

Vice-President –

- Must be a junior with at least one previous year participating in marching band

At-large/Auxiliary Representatives –

- Representatives will be elected from the sophomore and freshmen classes
- Should no office go to an auxiliary member, an ex-officio auxiliary representative will be elected by the members of the auxiliary

Student-elected officer's duties include organizing social events and leadership activities for the band, as well as being in charge of "Good Luck" signs for all Saturday events. They must attend all leadership events and planning meetings. All nominees must be band members in good academic and behavioral standing with BHS and the Highlander Marching Band.

To be eligible, students must submit the attached application and be elected by their peers.

Available *director-appointed* offices: up to two individuals per position

Librarian –

- Student(s) will be responsible for organizing and copying music
- Student(s) will be responsible for maintaining the music library
- Student(s) must commit to at least one afternoon of clerical work, per week, all year

Public Relations –

- Student(s) will share band/individual instrumental music success stories with BHS through the AM/PM announcements and submissions to Dr. Graves' blog
- Student(s) will promote all band activities/performances through a combination of hallway signs, AM/PM announcements and submissions to Dr. Graves' blog
- Students must commit to checking in on a weekly basis with Mr. Steele for information on upcoming events

Manager –

- Student(s) must arrive early to all rehearsals
- Student(s) are responsible for the following
 - Set up of field markers
 - Set up of "beast" rehearsal PA system
 - Preparation of water for rehearsal
 - Preparation/availability of rooms for sectionals
 - Band room set-up/clean-up

In addition to the weekly meetings listed above, director-appointed officers must attend all leadership events and planning meetings and must be members of the marching band in good academic/behavioral standing with both BHS and the band.

To be eligible, students must submit the attached application and will be appointed by the director and staff.
