Fair Share:

Each member will be responsible for paying a fair share of **\$75** to participate in the indoor program. This will cover the cost of the performers uniform for the season. Fairshare can either be paid through your Charms account or by making a check payable to the Baldwin Highlander Music Patrons. You can choose to pay all at once or in smaller increments. All fair share money must be paid by **January 17, 2023**.

Must Haves:

It is important that every member have the following items to assist in a smooth competitive season:

1. 1 roll of black electrical tape
2. 1 roll of blue electrical tape
3. 1 roll of white electrical tape (weapons)
4. Slip on shoes for competitions (flip flops, crocs, slides, etc.)

Weekday Rehearsals:

All members should make every effort possible to attend ALL week day rehearsals. We understand and encourage participation in various high school and middle school activities, so we will be as flexible as possible to allow our members to participate in all of their extracurricular activities.

Saturday Rehearsals:

Saturday rehearsals are MANDATORY for all members. There will be a great deal of content covered during these rehearsal times and any absence would take away from the development of our program. We do, however, understand that emergencies come up.

Expectations of Rehearsals:

Every rehearsal is important for individual and team growth. Prompt and enthusiastic attendance to all rehearsals is expected. Please wear proper rehearsal attire to all rehearsals. Rehearsal attire includes athletic clothes that are easy to move around in, bare feet or tennis shoes when required, and **no jeans**. All weapons will be required to wear gloves. Finally, we ask that you show respect and care for our equipment and/or props throughout the season.

Absences:

Absences from rehearsals and performances should be avoided at all costs. Please do not schedule doctors appointments, driving tests, personal care appointments, etc. during rehearsals. We are limited with the number of rehearsals that we have, and absences from those rehearsals creates an unproductive environment.

With that being said, we understand that emergencies do occur and some absences are unavoidable. If you are going to miss a rehearsal, please be sure to fill out an absence form.

When missing a rehearsal you understand:

1. I understand that I **MUST** inform a **DIRECTOR** of my absence in addition to filling out this form.
2. I understand that I am responsible for **LEARNING WORK** missed outside of rehearsal.
3. I understand that my absence from multiple rehearsals could result in being written out of portions of the show if I do not learn the work missed outside of rehearsal time.
